Move-Out Cleaning Checklist

This checklist must be presented to the inspector during the inspection.

1. General

- Windows (inside, outside, and in between) and frames must be cleaned.
- Window sills must be wiped on both the top and underside.
- Radiators: clean behind, between, around pipes, and thermostat controls.
- Doors: wipe the top of door leaves, door handles, and locks.
- Any pipes and water lines must be wiped clean.
- Walls and ceilings should be free from dust. Vacuum if necessary. Plastic plugs must be removed, and holes should be filled with filler, silicone, paint, or wallpaper.
- Electrical outlets must be wiped clean.
- Fuse box must be cleaned.
- Stickers and contact paper must be removed.
- Floors must be vacuumed and wiped.

2. Bathroom

- The inside and outside of the shower/shower walls are to be cleaned of soap and skin residue. The shower head and mixer are to be wiped down.
- Clean the floor drain/remove hair from under the grate. If it is a plastic drain, the water trap can also be removed for cleaning.
- The inside and underside of the sink are to be cleaned from residue. Pipes and the water trap under the sink should also be cleaned.
- The dryer must be cleaned — the drum, filter, heat exchanger, door, etc.
- The washing machine must be cleaned — the drum, detergent drawer, filter, door, etc.
- Toilet: remove the seat and clean both the top and underside of the seat.
- The inside of the bathroom cabinet should be wiped free from residue, including any sliding tracks for mirrors if present. Mirrors should be polished.
- Tiles should be wiped clean of soap and skin residue, especially in the shower area/cabin.
- Walls (from floor to ceiling) and floor should be wiped clean from residue.
- Other equipment should be wiped, such as light fixtures; ventilation vents should be cleaned.

3. Storage/Closets

- Doors and shelves must be wiped clean inside and out.
- Basement storage must be cleaned.

4. Kitchen

- All kitchen cabinets (inside, outside, and top edges) must be wiped clean. The cabinet frames above and below must also be wiped, including the underside of cabinets above the sink.
- All shelves inside kitchen cabinets must be wiped clean.
- Refrigerator and freezer must be pulled out, vacuumed, and wiped behind and underneath.
- Refrigerator and freezer must be defrosted and wiped inside and outside. Shelves and grates must be washed.
- Kitchen fan must be cleaned and degreased. Filters must be washed/degreased or replaced. Wall vents must be cleaned.
- Stove must be pulled out, and the floor, cabinet sides, and all sides of the stove must be wiped.
- The stovetop must be cleaned using stovetop cleaner and a scraper.
- Oven, including baking trays and racks, must be cleaned.
- Cutting board must be cleaned on all sides. Sink lighting must be cleaned.
- Dishwasher must be wiped outside and cleaned from food residues in the drain.

5. Balcony/Terrace

- Sweep/vacuum the floor.
- Balcony door (inside and outside) must be wiped clean.

6. Other

- All keys to the apartment, basement storage, and garage must be returned.
- All items purchased or taken over from the previous tenant must be removed. If you are unsure which items these are, please contact us.

About the Inspection

Unless otherwise agreed with the landlord, all cleaning must be completed before the inspection. If the cleaning is not completed before moving out, the landlord will charge you for the time required to restore the apartment.

Important: Do not forget to leave the router and TV box.
